# WHAT IS THE MEDSTEM EXPLORERS PROGRAM?

MedSTEM Explorers is an intensive academic enrichment program designed to introduce teens to a variety of STEM/healthcare careers, strengthen academic preparation, and develop leadership skills. Successful students in the MedSTEM Explorers program will be highly considered for the Internship program.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

Students will engage in hands-on learning to strengthen communication, teamwork, critical thinking and problem solving skills. In addition to skills development for higher education and career, students will have the opportunity to earn industryrecognized credentials and a stipend for the 6-week program.

#### HOW WILL I SPEND MY TIME?

Students will attend class at Rush University Medical Center exploring various STEM and healthcare careers, developing workforce skills, and researching real-world issues that affect their Chicago communities. Class is held on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 8:30am-4:30pm.

## HOW TO APPLY

Applicants can apply online! To complete the MedSTEM Pathways application, students will need to provide their **resume, medical record, a letter of recommendation, and an unofficial transcript**. REACH staff will collect, review, and decide whom to interview.
